## Copplestone's Putting Rail™

"The Million Dollar Putt"

A golf aid

Description: The Putting Rail is made of hard wood. It is 50" long, 3.5" wide and  $\frac{3}{4}$ " high. The finished hard wood board has a 2.5" cup hole and a  $\frac{7}{32}$ " tee hole and a convex top surface, one 48" label, and one golf tee.

The name of the game is Copplestone's Putting Rail™, a golf aid for 1 to 6 players per rail, taking 1/2 hour to 3/4 hour to play and about 5 minutes to learn. The putting rail is a putting device, to demonstrate and to improve a golfer's putting skills. The rail features a convex top surface that demands that you hit the ball straight.

The putting rail game "Hotshots" encourages players to show off their shot making skills as well as their ability to make strategic shot selections. Each player has eighteen putts in order to score more points than any other player in the field. They may choose to make each of their eighteen putts from any of the forty-eight locations on the rail, the further away from the cup the higher the point value.

Want to shave points off your golf score? Use the Putting Rail. The idea behind this golf aid is that the more time a golfer spends with a putter in their hand making smooth and consistent strokes, the more their putting game, and golf score, will improve. So choose among three engaging games that you can play on the golf rail and enjoy.
